

Emergency Relocation Shelter Agreement

In the event that there is a building emergency such as a bomb threat or gas leak, where children need to be several miles away from the facility, teachers will drive children to my home at 27 High Point Rd. Scarborough, which is 2.7 miles away. The State of Maine Child Care licensing department mandates that a relocation policy be in place and has given facilities permission to transport children without car seats for building emergencies. If this was to occur, all parents will be notified by phone and asked to pick up children at my home.

I hereby give permission for The Shooting Stars Program to use the home of Ruth Hughes at 27 High Point Rd Scarborough Maine as an emergency relocation site for my child_____. I understand that normal safety rules will be followed, as much as possible, but that the highest priority is to relocate to a safe location. I understand that due to the emergency, my child will need to be transported without their car seat.

This agreement will remain in effect for the duration that my child attends The Shooting Stars Program. The agreement may be terminated before my child is no longer enrolled at Shooting Stars by either party but only with written notification.
