



The “Creative Curriculum for Preschool” is an early childhood curriculum that focuses on project-based investigations as a means for children to apply skills and address four areas of development: social/emotional, physical, cognitive, and language. The curriculum is intended to foster development of the whole child through teacher-led, small and large group activities centered around 11 interest areas (blocks, dramatic play, toys and games, art, library, discovery, sand and water, music and movement, cooking, computer and outdoors). The curriculum provides teachers with details on child development, classroom organization, teaching strategies and engaging families in the learning process. Child assessments are an important part of the curriculum.
